

**Pakenham Parish Council**  
**Minutes of an extra ordinary Meeting of the Council**  
**held on Thursday, 3 March 2022 at 7pm in the Village Hall**

**Present:** Cllr Painter, Cllr Dorling, Cllr Davey, Cllr Palfrey, Cllr Sargent and Cllr Sidebotham

Four members of the public were in attendance.

Mrs S Brown (clerk) took the minutes.

1. **Record Councillors' apologies for absence:** *No apologies received.*
2. **Declarations of interest:** *None received*
3. **Public Forum:** *No members of the public wished to speak.*
4. **To consider the approval of the minutes of the last meetings:** *The minutes of the meeting held on 16 February 2021 were approved to be signed as a true record.*
5. **To consider reports:**
  - i. **Queens Platinum Jubilee June 2022 and Jubilee Mugs:**  
*Council discussed the possible purchase of jubilee mugs for the children of the village, to place on next agenda. The clerk to contact the company that produced the mugs for the diamond jubilee in 2012 and ascertain how much to provide mugs for the platinum jubilee.*  
*Council discussed the jubilee weekend, it was confirmed the W.I. to hold a 1950s afternoon tea in the village hall on the Saturday afternoon of the jubilee weekend with a request for £150/£200 funding. West Suffolk Cllr Brown advised he was happy to fund a lump sum for village events. The Chair of the PVH & PFA updated Council they were planning on replacing the benches at the playing field with new using recycled material with a plaque commemorating the jubilee, to try and obtain funding from County Cllr Hopfensperger and/or Cllr Brown. They were not planning to put on specific events for the jubilee however they were supportive of The Fox who were happy to put on something for the village. A resident advised a number of people had come forward with offers of help. It was advised The Fox hoped to put on something on the Saturday as well as Sunday midday to 6pm and were looking at a BBQ, various entertainment for children with cake and party food for children to be provided by volunteers. The group to put together a list of needs with costs to be given to Cllr Brown for funding to confirm further details at the next meeting.*

**6. Planning Applications to comment:**

- i. **Application DC/22/0190/FUL 1 Broadway – Detached garage and home office above:** Council discussed and all in agreement to object with the comments:
  - a. The Parish Council believes this application is invalid as the stated existing driveway/access onto Mill Road referred to on the application, which the Parish Council believe has never been granted access
  - b. The curtilage of the site includes land which is not part of the dwelling

**7 Councillors' reports and items for future agenda:** A resident volunteered to look after the kiosk on The Street if used as a library for children's books, to place on next agenda. Cllr Sidebotham to arrange a quote for shelves in the kiosk in preparation of the next meeting
